



CAMP RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

1. Camp Horizons is a **smoke-free** facility.
2. Camp Horizons is an **alcohol-free** facility.
3. Please frequent only the facilities to which your group has been assigned. Should members of your group desire to visit other camp facilities (horse area, ropes courses, etc...), they must be accompanied by a Horizons staff member. Groups are welcomed and encouraged to experience the natural beauty of camp and the surrounding area – hikes, campfires, and field games can be wonderful additions to your program. Ask your host/hostess if you have any questions about facilities usage while you are here.
4. There is **no swimming** in the lake or pool unless a Horizons staff lifeguard is present and on duty.
5. Groups are expected to leave facilities clean and in good condition upon departure. Trash should be placed in the dumpster behind the main dining hall at the end of your stay.
6. Camp is a wonderful place to experience the peacefulness that being in the country provides. **QUIET TIME IN CAMP IS FROM 9:00PM UNTIL 7:30AM DAILY.**
7. Your host/hostess will guide your group in the appropriate dining hall procedures. We generally serve cafeteria style unless you request otherwise.
8. Should you have maintenance problems during your stay, tell your host immediately. Camp has a full time maintenance person who will remedy the problem in a timely fashion.
9. Should you desire check-out materials (basketballs, tennis balls, etc...) contact your host. All check-out materials must be returned before your departure from camp.
10. **THE SPEED LIMIT IN CAMP IS 10 MPH.**
